BEHAVIOR POLICIES

Redland Christian Academy has a strict behavior policy. R.C.A. reserves the right to exclude students from school who refuse to accept direction and fail to abide by our rules of conduct (see the R.C.A. Student/Parent Handbook). The following are some of the R.C.A. policies that need to be emphasized at the time of enrollment.

- Profanity is not tolerated at R.C.A. Repeated offenses could result in suspension or expulsion. X_____ (parent's initials)
- At Redland Christian Academy we take bullying very seriously as a school, across the whole community, and will not tolerate bullying in school or online. We follow up all concerns expressed by children, staff or parents and make sure that we feed back the results of any investigation. Bullying is unacceptable behavior and will be addressed accordingly. It is the parent and student responsibility that any bullying is reported to the school administration. We always encourage children to report misconduct, making it clear that we take action when we know. X_____ (parent's initials)
- R.C.A. reserves the right to search the belongings of each student including the students' vehicles, book bags, pockets, shoes and socks etc. to enforce our No Drug Policy. R.C.A. also reserves the right to utilize Drug Dogs to search students, their belongings and vehicles if necessary and to require a student to be subjected to drug testing at random or as a condition of their continued enrollment at R.C.A. The cost of testing will be the responsibility of the parent.

- R.C.A. also utilizes security cameras throughout the campus. These cameras and recordings are sometimes used by the administration to investigate improper behavior on campus.

- Electronic devices are not permitted at school. This includes cell phones, ear buds, air pods, tablets, etc. If a student must carry a cell phone to use after leaving school, the phone should be turned in to the office or the student's homeroom teacher upon arrival at school to be held until the end of the day. R.C.A. will not be responsible for lost or stolen phones and electronic devices.
